## Percy Ironmonger Music Scholarship

Percy Ironmonger was the first Band Director at Tabb High School, and served in that capacity for over 20 years. Under his tutelage, the Tabb Tiger Band won numerous awards and high distinctions. The Tabb Tiger Band Parents offer college scholarship money in his name to a THS Band Program senior who exemplifies the pride, dedication, and commitment that were hallmarks of this award-winning Band Director.

Candidates for this scholarship must meet minimum requirements as listed below. To apply, complete the application form and requirements listed on the back of this paper and deliver your materials by the deadline listed. Please write neatly!

Scholarship candidates are evaluated using the "whole person" concept; meaning what counts is not only Band Program participation, but also overall conduct and demeanor both as a Tabb High School student and member of our community.

Selection of the recipient is made and approved through a process involving the THS Band Director, THS Staff, and Tabb Tiger Band Parents, Inc. (TTBP) board members. The scholarship is funded entirely by TTBP funds through student fees and fundraisers. Any TTBP board member with a senior band student is excused from the scholarship selection process.

The scholarship may not be awarded for a particular year if there are no qualified applicants; and at their discretion, the selection committee may choose to award more than one scholarship in any given year.

## **Criteria for Eligibility - Minimum Requirements**

A student wishing to be considered for this scholarship must meet the following minimum requirements:

- \* Graduating senior at Tabb High School who intends to continue music/guard participation and/or studies at either a two or four-year community college or university. Applicant must provide a copy of their college acceptance letter.
- \* Must be a current, active member of the Tabb High School Band Program in good standing with the TTBP.
- \* Must have been an active full-time member of the THS Band Program for two years (including senior year).
- \* Must be considered as "above average" in their abilities as determined by the Band Director.
- \* Must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 or better Grade Point Average (GPA). This must be confirmed and signed off by a Tabb High School Guidance Counselor or Guidance Secretary.

## **Decision Criteria**

**Required Performances:** Participation with the THS Band Program for at least two years, to include: band camp, scheduled performances, rehearsals, competitions, and festivals.

**Other Activities:** Voluntary participation in THS Band Program-affiliated activities beyond those required, for example: Tri-M, Solo and Ensemble Festival, Spring Musical Pit Ensemble, Winter Guard, Winter Drumline, and Honor Bands (All-District, All-State, college-affiliated, etc.).

**Leadership and Conduct:** Must have consistently demonstrated productive and positive conduct. Involvement in the THS Band Program Student Leadership Team (SLT) and/or maintaining leadership positions in other music and non-music organizations is preferred but not required.

**TTBP-Sponsored Activities:** Must have supported the THS Band Program by taking an active role in various TTBP-sponsored activities, such as: Tag Day, Fundraisers, and Service Projects.

**Outside School Activities:** Participation in other school and community activities and employment that contribute to the development of a well-rounded, disciplined, and responsible young adult.

**Essay:** Must complete and submit an essay (500 words or less) to explain the following:

- \* Why should you be selected to receive this scholarship?
- \* In what ways has participation in the THS Band Program prepared you for your future?
- \* What are your future plans in the area of band/guard performance?
