

Tabb Tiger Band Parents Board Meeting
April 13, 2015

Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM.

1. Adam Waller– Provided a briefing of the spring band trip and answered questions from parents.

2. Joe Ott reviewed the budget. Joe noted some issues that Julie Byrd pointed out about the budget after last meeting. Julie noted a discrepancy of approximately \$1800. Joe mentioned one of the items he discovered related to the Allentown trip and the owner significant item was shipping for uniforms. Joe discussed the remaining budget items scheduled for the remaining part of the year. It looks like we'll have about \$1200 remaining in the checking account at the end of the year. There was a brief discussion regarding how much money will be needed over the summer to get started. We should have enough to take care of Joe did send out the letter regarding activity fees that have still not been collected. He received very little response from the letters he sent out. The budget report was accepted.

3. Jennifer Williams, Student Accounts, noted that the current balance is \$4290.01. 17 students used their accounts to pay for the spring trip.

4. Pam Kelly – Discussed an Unos Band night plan. Unos will provide coupons in different colors so that they can track which class brings in the most customers. They will award a pizza party for the band grade level that raises the most money. Chick Fil-A still has too many other commitments and will not be able to help us with fundraisers at this time. Pam has had no luck with the new car wash on Rt 17. She has reserved One Stop Auto in front of Walmart for August 22. \$259 from Kroger. \$72 from concessions. Pam asked again for volunteers for Vice President.

Committee Reports:

1. Uniforms – Bernadette Marinaro was not present, however she provided a report via email. Bernadette noted that prior to spring break, there were still 5 students who had not turned in their marching uniforms or parts of uniforms. She will come into school sometime this week to check for any new returned items. Bernadette indicated that she had attempted to send email to both students and parents, however, she did not have correct email addresses and several emails came back as undeliverable. She suggested that she will likely need Mr. Waller's help in getting these last few items returned. Maureen Archer will begin working with Bernadette after the spring concert so that she can learn how things are done. Bernadette will need volunteers to help collect uniforms after the spring concert is completed. She will also need volunteers to help with laundering and repairs after everything has been returned.
2. Scrip Coordinator – Joe Matchette reported that he has received no input or interest from anyone from band members at this point. We discussed that we're getting close to the end of the year so we think that parents are not focused on their student accounts at this time. Everyone agreed that the program is set up now and will likely be very successful next year. Joe plans to give a presentation at the August parent meeting.
3. Pit Crew – We still don't have a chair for this committee.
4. Hospitality – Danielle is doing a great job getting ready for the end of year banquet.
5. T-Shirts – Mr. Waller is still working on T-shirts and plans to have them ready for the banquet.

New Business -- Tabb is hosting the District Jazz Assessment and Mr. Waller needs a volunteer to help with registration and provide information to attendees at the assessment. Terri Young volunteered to do this.

Percy Ironmonger Scholarship – Mr. Waller discussed the scholarship and choosing a due date for applications. We agreed on a May 1 deadline for applications so that the award can be announced at the banquet.
