Executive Board Report

- Band Director Mr. Lawson Introduced himself to band parents and asked those in attendance to introduce themselves and roles in TTBP organization. Thanked everyone for being here, "we cannot be successful as a band organization without you".
 - o Volunteering: Many events coming up that we still need chaperones,.
 - o <u>Forms</u>: sent out by Mr. Lawson please make sure that you and your students have read all of the information that is sent out weekly and to others.
 - Payments/Forms: spring trip is to Disney World mid-April. The commitment form is ready with non-refundable down payment of 100.00 due 9/25. If not turned in by 9/25 student will not attend, due to needing to block into plane tickets. Recommended to move date to 10/2 by band parents. If 50% of students don't commit to trip the trip will be cancelled. The trip estimate is \$720.00, which includes tickets, performances etc. reign of all parks, buses, metros, staying on resort. Chaperones will pay same amount as students for Disney Trip. Mr. Lawson will check with Mr. Parr to push date back to 10/2 for down payment of trip. Band parent requested a payment schedule. Pam also notified everyone that if you are planning to chaperone the same payment plan will apply to chaperones. Asking for support from the parents to stay on top of fees/forms/commitments. Checks are made out to THS not TTBP as the spring trip goes through the school, not the band.
 - Nationals: Leaving 11/7/15, staying in Allentown PA, returning 11/8/15. Performing in 3A class. Hotel is booked, rooming list will be posted on 9/15 for student sign up. 4 kids/room, 2 chaperones for 10 students. Transportation to Nationals by 55 passenger bus is 3700.00 @6400.00 for 2 buses or 1 bus that seats 88 passengers. Larger bus will allow for one bus which is easier in regards to parking, keeping everyone together, instruments and uniforms.
 - Next year August Calendar: Would like to change the structure of rehearsals, change half time band rehearsal to last week of August 5 day rehearsal. 4 weeks of intensive competition band rehearsal the beginning of August and would like to move rehearsals from 2-9 to 8-8.

 - o Band fee collection is much improved in comparison to 2014.
 - o 42 students have paid Nationals down payment
 - Bus fee depending on how we select bus transportation will affect us later in year. To
 meet the needs we have to take 2 smaller buses or 1 larger bus to meet
 student/chaperone needs and required guidelines. Currently we are in a good spot,
 currently operating in the black. \$12,600.00 w/o TAG day money submitted.
 - Maureen requested that we place a tab on web page where a list can be placed for what fees are due and the required submission dates.

 - \$1748.10 in student accounts currently. 6 students have used their accounts to use for activity fees.
