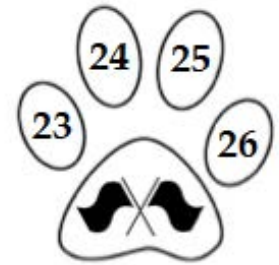




# TABB TIGER BAND TIGER PAW ORDER FORM
